



IMPORTANT 2009 TAX RETURN DOCUMENT

The fund chart below represents funds that have elected to pass through foreign tax credit to its shareholders. The dividends reported in Box 1 of your IRS Form 1099-DIV have been grossed up by the amount of the foreign tax credit. Box 6 gives the amount of foreign tax paid.

You can choose to take the foreign tax amount (Box 6) as a foreign tax credit or as an itemized deduction. To take the foreign tax credit, you may report it directly on Form 1040 if you pay foreign taxes totaling less than \$300 (\$600 if married filing jointly) and if your foreign taxes are all reported on 1099 forms. Otherwise, you must file Form 1116 to claim the credit.

If your fund is not listed, then please disregard this letter.
